

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 24<sup>th</sup> March of Two Thousand Twenty One (24.03.2021).

### BETWEEN

Govt. Polytechnic, Gajapati, At- Betaguda, Po- Jhami, Paralakhemundi, Gajapati- 761201, the **First Party**, represented **Principal** (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors in-office, administrators and assigns).

### AND

M. J. Steels, At- Gumma Road, Ranipeta, Gajapati - 761201, the **Second Party**, represented herein by its **Chief General Manager & Head** (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

### WHEREAS:

- A) The First Party is a Technical Educational Institution named: **Govt. Polytechnic, Gajapati Betaguda, PO- Jhami, Paralakhemundi, Gajapati- 761201.**
- B) The Second Party is a Technical Training Centre named: **M. J. Steels, At- Gumma Road, Ranipeta, Gajapati - 761201.**
- C) The All India Council for Technical Education has initiated a scheme to provide competency based skills under the National Skill Qualification Framework (Here in after to be referred as NSQF), by inviting various Institutions/ Organisations to join as Vocational Educational Institutions to provide education component and Skill Knowledge Providers to provide Competency Based Skills.
- D) Under the scheme, the Skill Knowledge Provider (here, **M. J. Steel, Ranipeta**) is required to perform the role and function of providing hands on skill training in a specific sector.
- E) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- F) The First Party is to participate as an Institution to register students under the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF);

- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Govt. Polytechnic, Gajapati**, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration will be dealt separately.

### **CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to

### **CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY**

- 4.1 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

### **CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
